

## Road Rally Introduction and Rules

The road rally is a chance for people to spend some time with friends, family or total strangers/soon to be friends, while working through a vehicular or scavenger hunt.

The goal is to get a picture of each of the answers to the clues at the way points, while completing the rally course. The course is timed.

- Pick your team.  
One team per vehicle.  
The team can be one or more people (however many that can safely & legally fit in/on the vehicle).
- Any road capable vehicle is valid (Car, Motorcycle, Van, Truck, 18-wheeler, ...)
- All drivers must have a valid driver's license.
- Each car must have current insurance.
- Each team needs a phone or digital camera.
- Teams will leave the church parking lot at staggered times, so you are not following each other around the course.  
The judge will release your vehicle onto the course and mark your start time.
- Each team will be given a set of instructions and a county map as they leave the parking lot.
- The team can travel to the waypoints in any order, though the course has been setup in a logical order.
- The team will need to determine their course.
- As each team comes to the waypoints, they are to come to a complete stop and a member of the team must get a picture of the landmark, item, or scene. There is no need to leave your car. Then proceed on to the next waypoint.
- Each team will be out on the course for 45 minutes to 100 minutes. (Can't tell you exactly how long...that's part of the competition)
- The standard time has been set with allowances for traffic.
- Return to church and present your pictures to the judge. The judge will mark your stop time when you cross the finish line.
- A helpline (phone a friend) is available, although use of the help-line results in a deduction of points. The helpline numbers will be released on the day of the competition.
- The team that finishes closest to the standard time, with the most waypoint pictures, and fewest deductions, will be the winner.
- Deductions will be given for getting back too early or too late and not getting pictures of all of the waypoint answers.
